SRRD Tax Exempt Status - As a follow-up to SRRD filing with the State its Articles of Incorporation and with the IRS for an EIN, appropriate forms with the IRS and State for 501(c) 4 status were submitted earlier this month. We will keep you apprised of the status of these filings when we receive that news.

### **INDUSTRY MATTERS!**

**Forestry** – In Nevada County, Supervisor Hank Weston is leading the way to ensure that more than \$1.7 M of the \$12.8 M the County residents pay in Fire Fees levied by the State returns to the County. Were you aware that 40 percent of the total fees go to the State's General Fund?

On another note, were you aware that the fuel buildup in our local forests are not only a fire danger and impact the effectiveness of Nevada County's fire breaks, but also limits the amount of winter snow reaching the ground that melts to recharge our ground water and surface water impoundments? If you would like to learn more about these issues please let us know so we can arrange for our member industries speak at an upcoming meeting.

**Mining** – There are two pieces of legislation that have been crafted largely by The Sierra Fund:

• <u>SB 209, SMARA Reform</u> – The Assembly Natural Resources Committee will host a hearing on 7.13.15 at 1:30 PM in Rm 447, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Capitol Building (old section). Key revisions: Section 2207 increases the annual filing fee from \$4,000 to \$10,000 and Section10 Section 2273.1 create undefined financial tests as a prerequisite to determine financial assurance amounts or up to \$4M or at least 25 percent of the financial assurance estimate, whichever is greater. Be there early, TSF has rallied its supporters to be there early to take up the available seating.

• <u>SB 637, Suction Dredging</u> - Assembly Water, Parks and Wildlife Subcommittee will host a hearing on 7.14.15 at 9:30AM in Rm160 at 1020 N Street in Sacramento. You may access the website "Stop SB637" at <a href="http://www.stop637.org">http://www.stop637.org</a> to learn more and sign a petition if you are unable to make the hearing.
